

Sanctioning Process

The Primary/Prime sanction of a race must be a legitimate membership organization. Barrel races can be sanctioned as a district race or a regional race (either of these are considered qualifiers for NWBHA finals).

- 1. Race producers should contact the district director for sanctioning of their event (contact regional directors if the event is not in an active district)
 - The listing of current district directors and their contact information can be found on the NWBHA website.
- 2. Once approved for sanctioning, producers will submit race information via the <u>Producer Portal</u> on the NWBHA website.
 - a. **New Producers**: contact info@nwbha.org or NWBHA Northwest Barrel Horse Association via Facebook Messenger to have a login created. Please note that the Producer's Name, Email, and Phone Number are required for login credentials.

Multiple shows on a given date within a single district may be sanctioned with District approval. District Directors must use good judgment in order not to create a travel distance hardship on members.

Shows will be sanctioned on a first-come, first-serve basis. The NWBHA reserves the right to refuse sanctioning for a particular date or show if it is determined not to be in the best interest of the NWBHA or its members.

The barrel race will be conducted in accordance within the rules and guidelines of the Primary/Prime Sanctioning body.

NWBHA Fee Breakdown

- 1. **Primary Sanction fee**: \$1 per run. Run fees will be paid for Open, Youth, and Senior contestants including no times (down barrels, off pattern, etc.).
- Co-sanction fee: At all races that NWBHA is the co-sanctioning organization, NWBHA members will pay an additional \$3 fee if they choose. Districts can change the co-sanction fee amount for District co-sanctioned races. Common scenarios include:
 - a. **NWBHA Finals Qualifier**: Contestants running in the Open and Senior, or Youth only need to pay one co-sanction fee per race for that race to count as a NWBHA Finals Qualifier (Members need 3 qualifier races to be eligible)
 - b. **District Points**: Contestants running at a co-sanctioned barrel race for district points will need to pay the co-sanction fee per class, per run, to earn district points.

After the Barrel Race

Within 2 weeks of the race date, Producers are asked to complete the following:

- 1. **Upload full results** via the <u>Producer Portal</u> on the NWBHA website
- 2. Send results via email along with a **co-sanction report** (list of contestants who have paid the NWBHA fee if applicable) to Sue Ruzicka at r4ranch2@gmail.com and info@nwbha.org.
- 3. **Mail prime sanction fees or co-sanction fees** and the Sanction Recap Worksheet for your barrel race to the appropriate NWBHA District Director. Fees are payable to the appropriate NWBHA District.
 - a. Races outside of an active NWBHA district that are co-sanctioned will mail fees (payable to NWBHA) Lisa Lee, 18325 W Charles Rd, Nine Mile Falls WA 99026.
- 4. **Mail any NWBHA Membership forms** and membership payments collected at the barrel race to Sue Ruzicka, PO BOX 10 Dixie, WA 99329

Membership & District Points

NWBHA does ask that race producers have copies of the NWBHA Membership form available at their races. Individuals may join at that barrel race and have it count as a qualifier for NWBHA Finals.

Points are not given on a regional level. Each district has autonomous discretion on if and how they do year-end points and awards. Individuals are encouraged to reach out to their NWBHA District Director for inquiries.

Finals Qualification

To be eligible to enter the NWBHA Finals all participants must have competed and/or entered with payment in (3) three NWBHA sanctioned shows during the qualifying year.


- An Open qualifier may count for a Youth or Senior qualifier (example: 2 Youth qualifiers plus 1
 Open qualifier = qualified for Youth).
- Note: A Youth qualifier or a Senior qualifier does not count as an Open qualifier

Members do not have to qualify at races within their stated district – any sanctioned race will count as a qualifier.

The Producer Portal


How to Login

The Producer Portal can be found at https://nwbha.org/producer.htm



After clicking the Login button, a **first-time producer** will be immediately taken to the New Event form.

A returning producer will be taken to the Scheduled Events Directory. This is a list of races that you as a producer have submitted in the past.




How to Submit a New Race

Once you've logged in, click on the Producer menu item → Add New Race




Complete the **New Event form** below, to the best of your ability. *It is highly recommended to include a PDF of your Entry Form and any PDF Flyers. Flyers may be used for social media advertising.* Once you've entered your information, be sure to check the **Submit for Approval** box at the bottom.



Copy a Previous Race

You can also choose to duplicate a previous race by using the *Copy Race* function from the *Scheduled Events Directory*. Navigate to the *Scheduled Events Directory* via Menu \rightarrow Producer. Click on the appropriate submenu item, and click **Copy Race**.




Click the **Create Copy** button.




Be sure to edit the *Event Title* and *Event Date*. The *co-sanctions, Flyer*, and *Entry Form* will not copy and need to be updated. At the bottom of the form, be sure to check the *Submit for Approval* box.

Edit an Existing Race & Upload Results

Navigate to the *Scheduled Events Directory* via Menu → Producer. Click on *Scheduled Events Directory* and click the **Details** button.



If editing an existing race: Update the necessary fields and uncheck the *Request Approval* box and click the gray *Update* button at the bottom of the page.



If uploading results, navigate toward the bottom of the Event Form and locate the Results Upload field. Please use a single PDF or JPG file and upload all results for that race at one time.

Once your results are uploaded, uncheck the *Request Approval* box and click the gray *Update* button at the bottom of the page.
